

Landrum Middle School Dress Code

The purpose of the dress code policy in any school is to set reasonable guidelines for students because inappropriate clothing worn by a student is detrimental to the school program. When students comply with the dress code, staff and administration spend less time dealing with inappropriate dress, and can dedicate more time to student learning. We appreciate your understanding and support of our dress code.

The following items should not be worn to school

- midriff or revealing clothing, (see through clothing)
- clothes with holes
- low cut shirts
- skirts/shorts more than 4" from the top of the knee
- frayed shorts, skirts, or jeans
- flip flops or backless shoes
- extreme hair/make-up (color and/or style)
- sleeveless clothing (tank tops/spaghetti straps)
- confederate flag apparel
- underwear worn as outer apparel
- pajamas worn as clothing
- sunglasses
- bandannas
- spandex shorts/yoga pants
- slippers
- swim wear/ board shorts
- roller skate shoes
- heavy chains
- dog collars

Guidelines

- Hats, caps, visors, other headgear, and/or gloves worn to school must be removed and placed in your locker during homeroom and not removed from your locker until the end of the day.
- No shirts with profanity or inappropriate slogans or advertising of alcohol, drugs, sex, weapons, racial and/or ethnic slurs, sadistic or violent themes
- No rings with sharp points or rings that cover more than one finger
- Students are not to write, apply glitter or place stickers on their bodies.
- ALL dresses, skirts and shorts must be hemmed and worn no shorter than 4" above the top of the knee/front and back.
- Pants must be appropriate length and not touch the floor
- Leggings, tights and 100% spandex garments must be covered by an approved outer garment that covers the area no shorter than 4" above the top of the knee/front and back.
- Belts, overalls and suspender straps must be fastened and worn appropriately at all times.

Items determined to be a distraction by the administration will not be allowed.
